ALWS CHRISTMAS ACTION 2023:

The goal for Australian Lutheran World Service Christmas Action 2023 is to support 2,500 learners with disabilities in Somalia to go to school. Also to

support 1,000 younger children with disabilities to receive the support they need to live life to their potential. To do this, ALWS aims to raise \$30,859 by 31 January 2024, to be matched 5:1 by the Australian Government.

Why you are needed?

In Somalia, 60 per cent of the population is under 18 years old. Life expectancy is only 51.5 years. After 5 years of drought, 1.4 million people are displaced from their homes. Eighty per cent of these people are women and children. Children with disabilities struggle the most because they face stigma and rejection, inadequate facilities, a lack of health services, neglect, psychosocial distress, and forced child labour. Children with disabilities miss out on education because there is a lack of disability-trained teachers and disability-friendly learning materials, latrines, desks and uniforms. Parents also have a high rate of poverty. They are invisible in Somali society, often hidden at home, and there is a low awareness and advocacy for their needs.

Every donation you make to this project will be combined with funding from the Australian Government to reach more people. ALWS has committed to contribute \$1 for every \$5 received from the government. Your donation will allow us to extend our programs.
